



Coaches' Code of Conduct

The purpose of this code is to establish guidelines for standards of conduct for coaches who are coaching all Saskatchewan Team Handball Federation events.

A Coach Must:

- Respect the rights, dignity, and worth of each player
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with each player based on mutual trust and respect
- Display and promote high standards of behaviour
- Explain what they expect of their players and what their players should expect of them
- Encourage each player to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance
- Show respect to others involved in the game including officials, opposition players, coaches, managers official, and spectators
- Adhere to all guidelines laid down by governing bodies
- Ensure the safety of all players
- Failure to comply with the expectations of the STHF or the outlined code of conduct will result in your being sent home at your own expense. Further sanctions will be considered by the Board of Directors.

I understand that breaches of the code may result in action being taken by the STHF.
